1. Using the case below to answer the following questions:

Kungwa and Agnes have been married for the past 15 years. They are blessed with two children, Felix (14yrs) and Angela (5yrs). They both hailed from a culture which believes that the families marry, and marriage exists at the payment of a dowry (bride's prize). Agnes is a member of the Roman Catholic Church, and Kungwa is a member of a Pentecostal Church. The couple approached you for psychotherapy. Kungwa and Agnes' presenting problems included unresolved hurts, excessive anger toward each other, manifested in daily verbal fighting, and poor communication skills. They often fought about their religious difference and Kungwa's resentment over Agnes' efforts to convert him to Roman Catholicism. They acknowledged that their main motivation for keeping the marriage together was their two children. Felix had recently disclosed that he is gay. While they are battling with the threat to divorce from Agnes, their concern over Felix's disclosure placed them in the state of ambivalence.

a) As a counselor who is both competent in psycho-spirituality and multiculturalism, discuss how you can use holistic approach to help the couple.
