- Q2. Before Martin Luther a number of people had tried to revolt against the Church but their revolts were not a success and yet the one of Martin Luther was a success. Point out the factors that led to the success of the revolt of Luther. **(24 marks)**
- Q3. Trace how the Church in England ended up breaking relationship with Rome pointing out how Calvinistic and Lutheran ideas found their way into the Church of England. **(24 marks)**
- Q4. Taking responsibility of his statements and aware of the imminent excommunication in 1520 Martin Luther wrote a number of reformatory tracts. Discuss his major reformatory tracts pointing out the salient issues therein. **(24 marks)**
