- Q3. Explain the symbolism of the matrimonial ring and suggest possible alternatives for a possible inculturation.
- Q4. What are the “new elements” that have been introduced in the 2004 Edition of the Rite of Marriage (not yet translated into English).
- Q5. Discuss the Greco – Roman influence on the development of the Christians Rite of Marriage.
- Q6. Briefly explain and justify:
- a) Canonical form of marriage

- b) Validation of marriage.
- Q7. Discuss the celebration of marriage between a Catholic and a non – Catholic Christian.
