- Q3. The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is biblically founded. Explain.
- Q4. The period between the 8th and 12th centuries was characterised by the rich documentation of the praxis of Anointing of the Sick. Mention and explain briefly three types of rituals for the Anointing of the Sick found in the medieval “*ordines*”.
