Other Governor Chenumba, wants the police to bring criminal defamation charges against Malinda. The Anti-terrorism unit has arrested Malinda subject to the Prevention of Terrorism Act.
 - i). You are an intern at article 19 organization, the director has asked you to write a draft on Malinda's possible defences for breaching the Prevention of Terrorism Act. (10marks)
 - b) Using the ruling that justice Mativo delivered; discuss why a criminal defamation prosecution would be dismissed. (5marks)
 - c) What Kenyan law provides for protection of journalists such as Malinda from threats and physical violence. (5marks)
