- Q1. For close to 50 years the people of Never Never (NN) had been engaged in a war of independence from the Republic Kurz. In 2012 NN gained its independence after long and sometimes acrimonious negotiations.
In 2015 Akol, a member of NN parliament introduced a bill whose effect would be to move the Republic of NN into a customs union with 4 other countries in the region.
The president of the Republic of NN is not clear about the ramifications of being a member of a regional body and has invited you to make presentations on whether it is advisable for NN to join up with its neighbours. **(30Marks)**
