- Q1. Give a concise exposition on the formation of the Pentateuch and the factors underlying such a process
- Q2. The books of Deuteronomy and Joshua reflect Assyrian strategies of “psychological warfare” (nationalistic and militaristic propaganda). Explain and comment on some of the passages in each of them.
- Q3. Analyze Jeremiah 15:15-21 as a prayer outside the Psalter (structure, types, content....).
- Q4. “The Cross of Christ is the watershed, the decisive event of Salvation”. With reference to the Letters of Paul and especially to the Galatians explain the significance of the Cross in the Gospel preached by the Apostle to the Gentiles.
- Q5. John opens the Gospel in 1:1 with the primal and archetypal state of being – the Logos was and was God and in 1:14 the Logos became flesh. Expound on the significance of these affirmations for the understanding of the Gospel of John.
